What is Uwill?

• Uwill is a behavioral health service specifically designed for college students. Uwill is contracted with Counseling & Psychological Services (CAPS) to increase access to timely mental health support for students in need.

Who can access this service?

• For the time being, Uwill is available to all registered UCSB students, regardless of insurance status.

What services are available?

 All students have access to credits, which can be used for a combination of chat messaging and 30-60 minute teletherapy sessions. If you have questions about accessing credits, please contact CAPS. Language abilities & extended appointment times may be available.

Does this limit my access to care on campus?

• No! As a registered student, you have access to campus services. You can access counseling 24/7 by calling CAPS at (805) 893-4411.

How do I access Uwill?

 Access to Uwill is granted by a referral from UCSB mental health campus providers, such as CAPS, Alcohol & Drug Program, and Social Work. After making an initial appointment with any provider and requesting a Uwill referral, visit app.uwill.com and register with your @ucsb.edu email.
